Dogs in flats

In flats, only small dogs (under 10kg when adult) will be allowed. Below is a list of suitable breeds. The list is not exhaustive. Please speak to your Housing Officer before getting a dog.

The table below is a guide to dog breeds that would be acceptable, although it is not an exhaustive list. Cross breeds will be considered depending on their likely size.
